

Alaskan Trip Supplies Punchlist:

This is the punch list we use when we head to Alaska for Moose. It is not exhaustive and we try to go light so it only takes 1 trip in for 2 men in a plane that has 700lb capacity. Your weight limits will determine what you can bring. Also consider your ability to transport everything to and from Alaska. The difficult part is getting it from Anchorage or Fairbanks to your final destination in the bush. A good option is to rent bulky and heavy portions of your gear from your pilot (many rent gear).

Critical:::

- Hunter Orientation (For units it is required)
- License (Hunting Fishing)
- Locking Tag
- State park permit (If required)

Group Gear:

- Big tent
- Small tent (spike camp)
- 100' of paracord for hanging quarters
- 10' Tape Measure (puts your mind at ease with a 50" minimum spread)
- Hatchet
- Hand saw.
- Bone saw for skull capping (optional)
- Lighters (BIC is fine)
- Fire Starter
- Headlamps (2 sets of batteries extra)
- Game Bags (10 large and heavy-duty)
- Fishing Poles
 - 12lb test
 - lures (panther martin yellow/black)
 - Split shot
- FIRST AID KIT
- PAIN KILLERS (Aleve or stronger if you can)
- Raft (optional for travel or floating moose. Ask pilot if has one available to rent)

Personal Gear:

- Rain Gear
- 14 pairs of socks (Darn Tough)
- fleece or wool base layer (top and bottom)
- 4 t-shirts
- 2 long sleeves
- Kuiu superdown jacket or equivalent is good
- 2 pairs of pants
- 6-8 pairs of underwear
- Wool gloves
- Warm Hat

- Kienneetrek or Crispis Boots
- Camp shoes are always nice but not necessary
- Gaiters (Kuiu Yukon Gaiter is excellent)
- Waders (Always handy but not necessary if you don't mind getting wet!)
- Mosquito head net (2 in case you lose one)
- Mosquito repellent (100% deet)
- Sleeping Bag (0 degree)
- Sleeping Pads
- Space blanket (good for marking location for pilot too)
- Knife and sharpener or Outdoor Edge with 6 replacement blades
- Water bottle
- Water filter

Food:

- Freeze dried meals
- Spices (montreal / lemon pepper)
- Tin Foil (cook fish and meat)
- Jet Boil
- 3 big gas canisters
- Frying pan
- Forks and spoons
- Bowl / plate
- Tin Cup
- Trail Mix
- High energy snack food
- Instant potatoes
- Ramen Noodles
- Coffee / Creamer / Sugar / Filter / Brewer
- Oatmeal (instant and flavored)

Toiletry:

- Wipes
- TP

Defense:

- Bullets / Ratshot (Ptarmigan)
- Pistols
- Bear Spray (optional)

Communications:

- Walkie Talkies
- Garmin InReach (can text pilots)

Optics:

- Spotting Scope
- Bino's (I use Vortex Razor 12x50)
- Range Finder

Camera Gear:

- Extra batteries
- Extra SD card
- Recharger
- POV camera
- Tripods
- Phone Skope
